



Loc Extensions

AFTERCARE

- Gentle cleansing: If you opt for "at-home" washes. Wash your loc extensions using a mild shampoo. Gently massage the scalp and roots, while avoiding excessive rubbing or pulling on the extensions.
- Drying: After washing, gently squeeze out excess water from your loc extensions and pat them dry with a towel. Avoid using a rough towel or vigorous rubbing, as it can cause frizz or damage.
- Adequate moisture for your locs and scalp: It is crucial to provide proper moisture to your loc extensions and scalp. Regularly moisturize them using a lightweight, water-based moisturizer or a specialized loc oil. Give extra attention to the roots and ends of your locs to prevent dryness and minimize the risk of breakage. To achieve this, you can lightly mist the entire length of your locs with Locs by Lisa Hydrating Mist before applying Locs By Lisa Herbal Oil. However, keep in mind that misting your scalp may lead to faster frizzing, so apply the products with care.
- Avoid excessive manipulation: Minimize excessive touching, twisting, or pulling of your loc extensions. Excessive manipulation can weaken the bonds and lead to premature loosening or breakage.



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- Sleep care: Protect your loc extensions while sleeping by wrapping them in a satin or silk scarf or using a satin or silk pillowcase. This helps reduce friction, tangles, and frizz.
- Avoid swimming or excessive wetting: Refrain from swimming or exposing your loc extensions to excessive water. Water can compromise the integrity of the installation and disrupt the locking process. If you do come into contact with water, gently pat dry with a towel.
- Avoid tension styles and accessories: Steer clear of hairstyles or accessories that put excessive tension on your loc extensions. Avoid styles that pull or stretch the hair, as it can compromise the integrity of the installation. Opt for looser styles and gentle accessories to preserve the longevity of your locs.
- Regular maintenance: Schedule regular maintenance appointments with your stylist to have your loc extensions checked and tightened if necessary. This helps maintain the longevity and neatness of your locs.
- Handle with care: Treat your loc extensions gently when styling, detangling, or tying them up. Avoid pulling or tugging forcefully, as it can stress the hair and cause breakage. Opt for hairstyles that put less strain on the roots, such as loose updos or braids.
